STATE CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS



1. THE CHAMPIONSHIP

Motorcycling WA (MWA) shall approve a series of events during the 2018 calendar year known as the State Road Race Championship.

The 2018 State Road Race Championship will be run over four (4) rounds.

Each championship round will consist of 3 legs.

Competitors will count ALL legs at each round towards the final point score to determine each championship. If a leg is not run on the specified day, it shall NOT be re-run.

The competition will be conducted under Motorcycling Australia Permit as issued by MWA and run under the rules as stated in the 2018 Manual of Motorcycle Sport (hereafter referred to as MOMS), these State Championship Regulations, Series Supplementary regulations and round Supplementary Regulations.

2. ELIGIBLE CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

The competition is open to holders of current NATIONAL Motorcycling Australia competition licences. One event competition licenses will be evaluated at the promoters

Eligibility and Definition of:

Superbikes	2018 GCR MOMS 9.18.
Supersport	2018 GCR MOMS 9.19
Sidecars	Open to Formula 1, Formula 2, Period 5 machines as per 2018 GCR MOMS.
125GP	2018 GCR MOMS
Production	2018 GCR MOMS 9.21 up to 400cc
Production	2018 GCR MOMS 9.21 up to 400cc

3. MINIMUM NUMBERS REQUIRED TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

At a Round:

The minimum number of entries required to constitute a Championship class will be seven (7) for solo bikes and five (5) for sidecars.

There must be a minimum of seven (7) solo or five (5) sidecar starters for Championship points to be allocated for each leg. No championships shall be appointed if there are less than the required starters, however the leg can be run.

Series:

Superbikes, Supersport, Production, Women and Sidecars: There must be at least seven solo starters and 5 sidecar starters in at least 3 of the 4 rounds for a Championship to be declared in that class.

4. ALLOCATION OF GRID POSITIONS

Grid positions for the first race/leg of the first round only, will be determined by qualifying.

All remaining races/legs will start as per the finishing order of the previous race/leg.

Grid positions for subsequent races/ legs will be determined from the finishing order of the previous race/leg, as per **2018 MOMS RR 10.12.7 for Solos and 10.12.8 for Sidecars.**

Riders who do not start (DNS) or finish (DNF) in a leg will be allocated positions at the rear of the grid for the next leg.

5. STARTING PROCEDURE

All solo and sidecar races will be clutch starts from echelon style grids. For 2018 Solos will be 3/3/3 and Sidecars will remain at 2/2/2.

6. POINT SCORE SYSTEM

Points will be allocated to the first twenty (20) placegetters in each leg of the Championship in accordance with GCR MOMS 9.12.16.

In the event of a tie at the completion of an event, GCR MOMS 9.12.16.2 and 9.12.16.3 shall be used to declare the winner.

7. SEEDED RACING NUMBERS

The competitors who finished 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the Championship classes of the 2016 MWA State Road Race Championships may use the seeded numbers 1, 2 and 3 respectively.

Competitors taking this option will have their normal permanent racing number withheld by MWA to allow it to be returned if/when the competitor no longer qualifies to use the seeded numbers.

8. AWARDS

2018 CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS FEES

The Promoter of each championship round shall pay a fee determined by Motorcycling Western Australia for the provision of Championship awards.

Motorcycling Western Australia will invoice the Promoter for their share of the awards fee at the end of each round.

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented to the first three overall place getters in the State Championship at the completion of the season. These may be presented at an MWA awards function to be announced. Each Championship placegetter finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd will receive 1 complimentary ticket to attend the MWA Awards Function. All placegetters are expected to attend.
