2020 JUNIOR TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

1. MACHINE ELIGIBILITY

The below rules apply to machines competing in the Junior State Road Racing Championships promoted by the Motorcycle Racing Club of WA. All protests to be as per MOM GCR section 6.2.

All machines must meet GCR sections 8B, 8C and 8D, with 4-stroke machines also meeting 8.28, and two-stroke machines also meeting 8.27. The MA General Competition Rules (GCR) and this document which takes precedence over the GCRs.

2. FOUR-STROKE – 160CC MACHINES

As Per 8.28 (junior 160cc four-stroke) of the 2020 MA GCRs with the addition of the following items.

8.28.5: Permitted Additions. **Add the following.**

- d) **Commercially available brake lever protection.**

2.1. CLARIFICATIONS

8.28.4 Permitted Modifications.

- f) Front suspension damping components may be replaced, however, Inner and outer fork tubes, and the fork base (axle lug) must remain OEM and un-modified.

- k) Engine and Gearbox breather tubes, and the radiator overflow bottle may also vent to an overflow bottle with an effective capacity of no less than 250 ml.

3. TWO-STROKE – 85 CC MACHINES

As Per 8.27 (junior 85cc) of the 2020 MA GCRs, with the addition of the following items.

8.27. Add or amend the following.

8.27.3 Permitted Modifications

- d) **Front suspension damping components may be replaced, however, Inner and outer fork tubes, and the fork base (axle lug) must remain OEM and un-modified.**

- e) Brake Friction materials **and brake hoses**

- h) **Rear suspension damping units and springs.**

8.27.4 Permitted Additions

8.27.4.1 The following may be added:

- a) **GPS lap timer only, the only electronic or other connection to the machine shall be for the purpose of power supply to the lap timer only.**

- b) **Frame protective sliders**

- c) **Radiator guards**
